Akhter strengths

This specific project provided Akhter with two challenge's

- 1. Supply of just under 3000 off Read only, thin client, kiosk laptops running the very latest embedded Microsoft Windows 8.1 operating system.
- 2. 6500 off Microsoft Windows to Go devices running the latest Microsoft Windows 8.1 operating system supported by the Laptops and managed by the Microsoft Windows InTune Mobile Device Management platform.

Akhter's team along with Toshiba developed locked down (Mod CESG compliance) embedded and standalone images for the Laptop's and WTGO devices. Akhter's production and customisation department then implemented the solution incorporating image / asset management, Key management services, MDM for device and application support and custom PowerShell scripting as required. Background

In 2015 Akhter Computers plc tendered for a contract for the provision of Mobile Devices and Mobile Device Management (MDM), InTune, for the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst (RMAS).

Mobile Device Management Service

Akhter provide these services through the Microsoft Intune cloud subscription service and via the devices wireless connectivity for inservice use and via the Rebuild in-house custom service for new/replacement devices. Devices were pre-configured for connectivity on the Mobile Device Management (MDM) application InTune prior to leaving Akhter.

Akhter successfully provided all equipment to the desired specification well within the agreed timescales and has provided management of both services to the Army facilities since their commissioning into service. These installations and all documentation relating to the management services can be offered as references to show that Akhter has effective, proven experience of managing such a service.
